








IELTS Scores and CEFR

Corresponding CEFR Level	IELTS approximate band score
C2	8.0+
C1	7.0/7.5/8.0
B2	5.5/6.0/6.5
B1	4.0/4.5/5.0





Cambridge exams and CEFR

CEFR level	Cambridge exam
A2	A2 Key
B1	BI Preliminary
B2	B2 First
C1	C1 Advanced
C2	C2 Proficiency

Recommended time to prepare for a Cambridge exam is minimum 120 hours





Writing	Speaking






What do we need to teach them?
