

















- Bengkala Deaf Inclusive Education (BDIE)
  - o Official: 2007
  - STUDENTS
    - From 2007 to 2025, 18 deaf students (9 graduated, 6 are still studying, and 3 did not graduate for various reasons.
    - Various surrounding places
    - Today, a total of 72 students 6 deaf students – 4 (original); 2 (neighboring village)
  - TEACHERS
    - 8 teachers and 2 admin staff
    - 2 signing teacher (1 hearing), 1 (deaf; volunteer)
